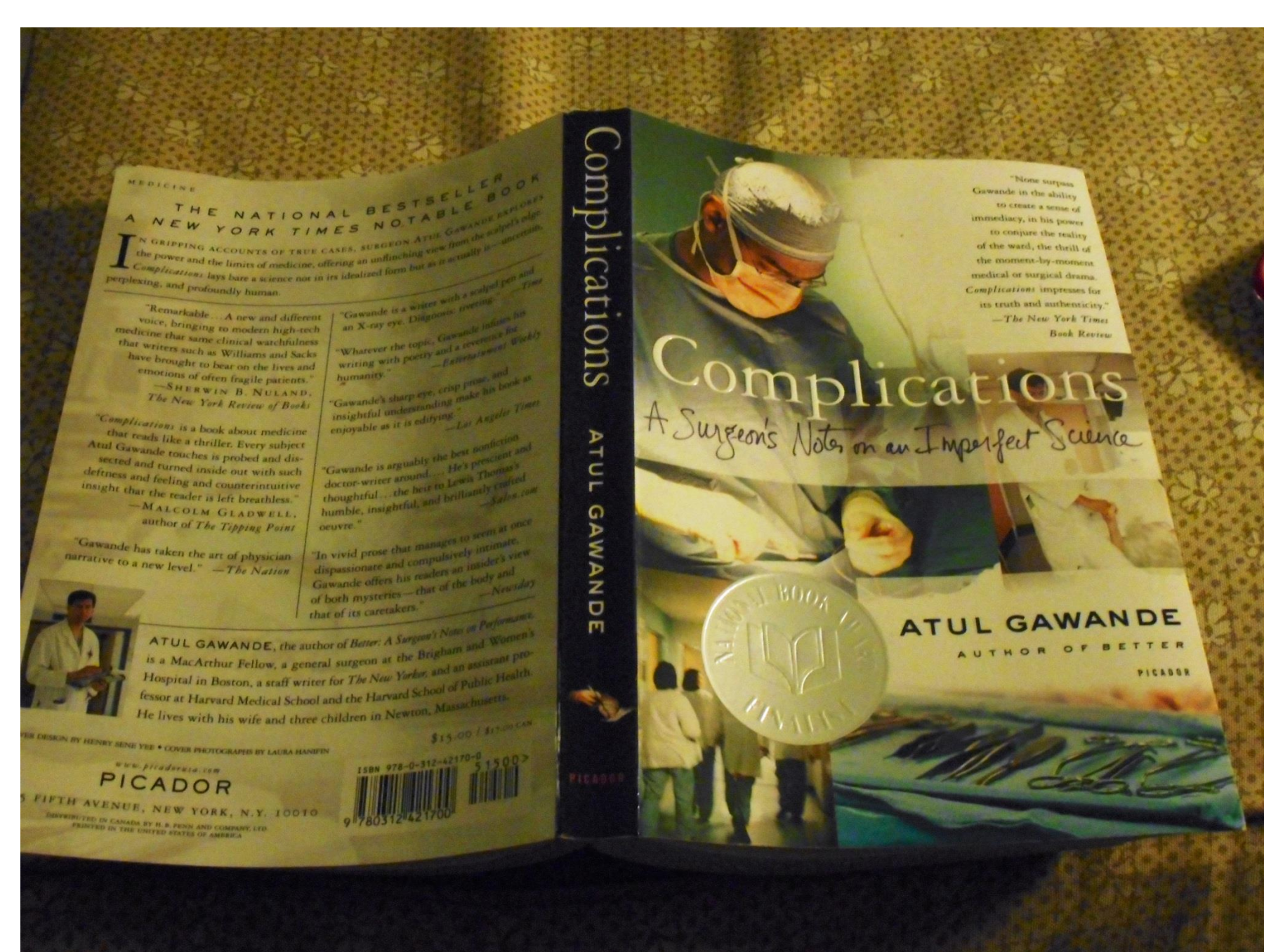
“I want everyone to know that home health aides are not unskilled but go through training.”
